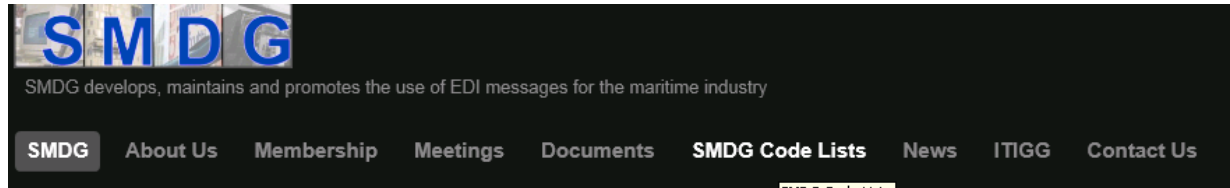

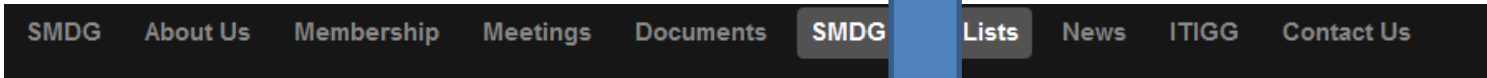

# Terminal Facilities List

Main purpose:

**Indicate the discharge location of a container if a vessel calls at multiple terminals within a port**

Identification of terminals:

**Unique by a combination of UN/LOCODE and Terminal Code**

# Terminal Facilities List - Status

## New Layout:

New column:

“alternative UN/LOCODE’s” (only on request)

*Why?*

Different parties may use different valid  
UN/LOCODES

*Example:*

Deltaport

CAVAN = Vancouver

CADEL = Delta

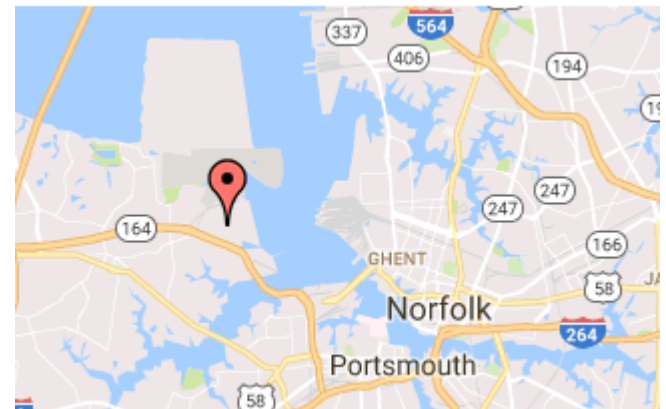
