# BAPLIE / MOVINS Status

- BAPLIE v2.x is still the most commonly use version, but acceptance of BAPLIE v3.x is slightly increasing

- MOVINS version 2.1.2 is in use, MOVINS v3 not yet released
- Current message versions 2 need adoption to current business processes

# Maintenance Issues

- Adjust Guidelines for reference to **Standard Code Lists**
  - SMDG code lists
    - HANDLING
    - STOWINS
    - ATTRIBUTES
- Apply **SMDG Recommendation#7**
  - use latest code list, even if message structure is D.95B

# Use of Standard Code Lists

- old: Codes defined in MIG
    - no reference to external code lists
    - Information transmitted as “literal text” – not as “coded reference”
    - FTX segment: FTX+<text subject code qualifier>  
 +<free text function code>  
 +<coded reference to standard text and its source>  
 +<text literal as free text>
    - Example “away from foodstuff”  
**FTX+HAN+++AF’**
  - new: Codes defined as coded reference
    - Example “away from foodstuff”  
**FTX+ACB++AF:STO:306’**
- D.95B
- D.00B and later
- HAN+AF:STOWINS:306’  
 ATT+27++AF:STOWINS:306’

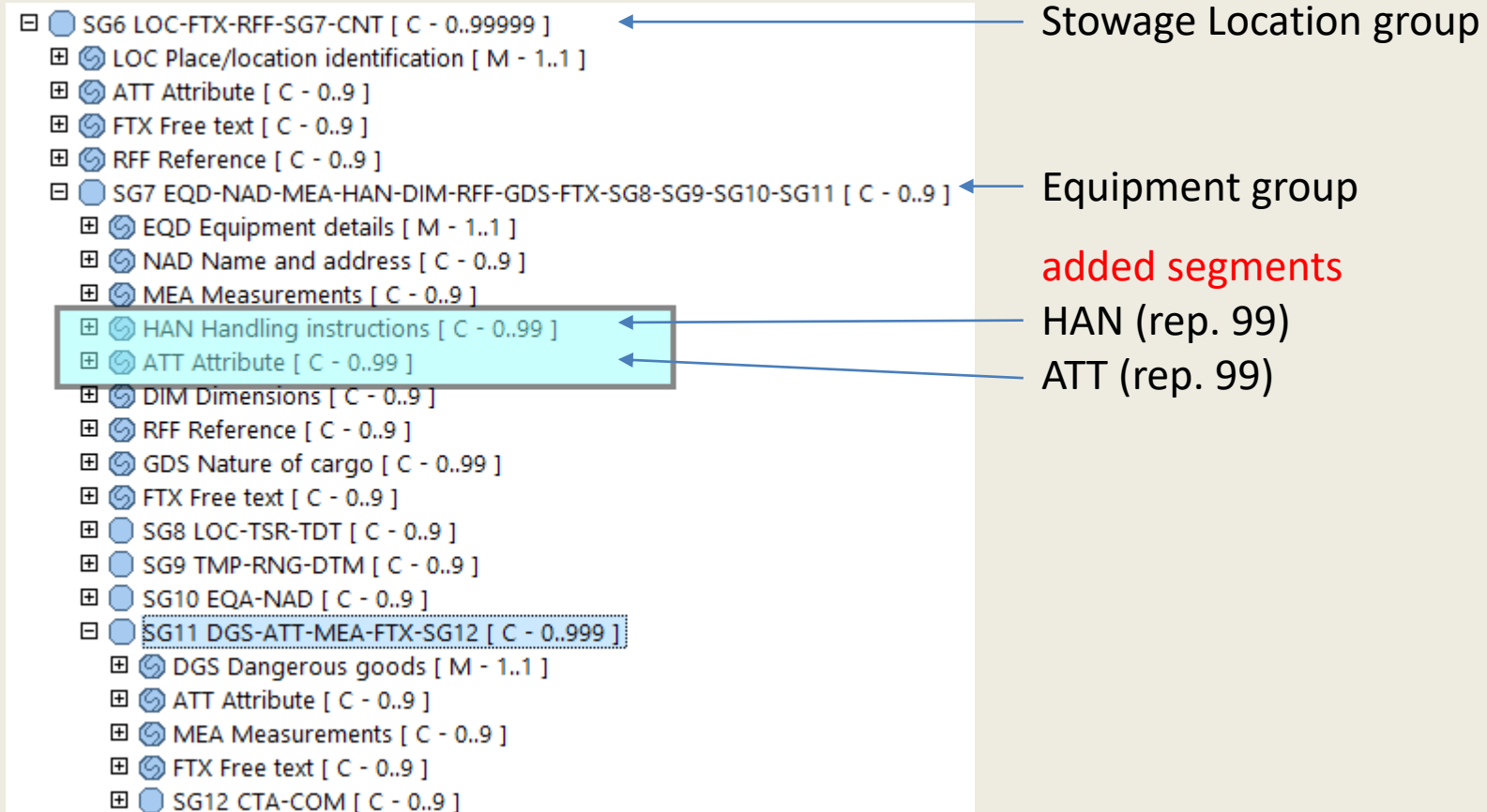
## Maintenance Issues (2)

- Amend message structures by new segments **HAN** and **ATT**
  - implies DMR for new directory version
- (with that) overcome requirement for transmission of codes in **FTX** segments
