

Analysis of FAL Convention

- No new accessions in the last two and a half years (90.3% of the world's fleet by tonnage)
- "Comprehensive revision of the Convention", decided in FAL 35 (2009). Two phases: first only Annex. Later, the Convention, looking for text more binding. Correspondence group leaded by France
- FAL 36 approved explanatory Manual



Electronic means for clearance of ships

- FAL 37 approved
 - FAL.5/Circ.35 on Revised IMO Compendium on Facilitation and Electronic Business
 - FAL.5/Circ.36 on Guidelines for setting up a single window system in maritime transport.



Stowaways

- Resolution FAL.11(37) on "Revised guidelines on the prevention of access by stowaways and the allocation of responsibilities to seek the successful resolution of stowaway cases". Became effective on 1 October 2011.
- IMO focal point: continuation of trial until FAL 38
- Proper implementation of SOLAS XI-2 and ISPS Code

Access to the electronic versions of documents and certificates of the ships

- Important decision for future work of FAL Committee
- Correspondence group leaded by the USA, to report to FAL 38.



Security

- MSC/FAL circular on questionnaire on information on port and coastal State requirements related to PCASP on board ships
- Development of guidelines towards enhancing the resilience of maritime shipping. Correspondence group leaded by USA and Canada

Ship/Port interface

- Dangerous Goods Denial Database (IMO, IAEA and ICAO) and so far there were 236 reports in the database (182 relating to sea-mode, 51 to air-mode and 3 to land-mode)
- Continuation of trial period of the mechanism for the resolution of IMDG Code dangerous goods including class 7 radioactive materials
