HARMONISATION PROCESS at 3 levels:

- General Recommendations

Applicable to all EDIFACT Transport Messages

- Principles and Rules (P&R)

Per type of messages ex : Maritime freight and containers movements

- Implementation reference guidelines

For specific messages ex : Bayplan, containers

- Business domains

Maritime, Road, Rail, Multimodal, Multiconsignment,

Status reporting, Multiconsignment, Dangerous goods, Freight ost

CENTRAL CODING MAINTENANCE

- Including ' temporary ' codes pending inclusion in official EDIFACT lists
