# Terminal Facilities List: Status

Main purpose:

**Indicate the discharge location of a container if a vessel calls at multiple terminals within a port**

UN-Locode	Company Name	Terminal Facility	Terminal Code	<u>last change</u>	<u>valid from</u>	<u>valid before</u>
SEGVX	Gävle Stevedoring Company	Granudden Terminal	GVXGU		2007-10-31	

1. Indicate terminal - not berth  
Updating is in progress
  2. UN-Location Codes / Terminal Codes  
Terminal codes are not unique
- Unique identification of terminals by combination of UN-LOCODE and Terminal Code

# Terminal Facility Code: UN-LOCODE

But: UN-Location Codes are not unique either

- several codes for the same port

	CN SGH	Shanghai	Shanghai	31	12345---
	CN SHA	Shanghai Hongqiao International Apt	Shanghai Hongqiao International Apt	31	12345---
	CN SHG	Shanghai Pt	Shanghai Pt	31	1-3-----

- district versus greater area  
CAVAN = Vancouver  
CADEL = Delta



# Terminal Facility Code / UN-LOCODE

## Next steps:

- Integrate multiple valid UNLOCODES indicating the greater area and district within this area into the Terminal Facilities List.
- Prepare a list of all ports with multiple UN-LOCODES
